## **Title IX Notice of Nondiscrimination**

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 ("Title IX") prohibits discrimination based on sex in education programs and activities in federally funded schools at all levels. Title IX protects students, staff members, applicants for admission and employment, and other persons from all forms of sex discrimination based on sex based harassment, sex stereotypes, sex characteristics, pregnancy or related conditions, sexual orientation and gender identity.

The Academy does not discriminate on the basis of sex in its education programs or activities. This means all academic, educational, extracurricular, athletic, and other programs of the Academy, that take place on Academy premises, in an Academy vehicle, or at any other Academy-sponsored activities or events, including events that take place off of Academy's premises, and conduct subject to the Academy's disciplinary authority, including even when some conduct alleged to be contributing to the hostile environment occurred outside the Academy's education program or activity or outside the United States.
